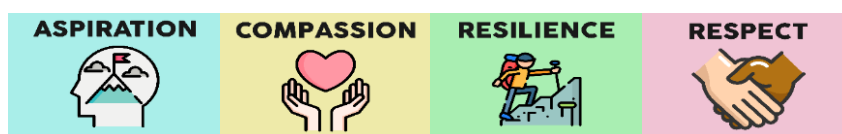
Have a lovely half term and we look forward to starting the new term on 3rd June 2024.
