WhatsApp and Facebook

It has come to my attention that several students are using WhatsApp and Facebook in ways that raise serious safety concerns. Specifically, we have observed:

- Sharing of inappropriate content and language.
- Instances of cyberbullying.
- Late-night messaging.
- Allowing strangers into WhatsApp groups.
- Sharing personal information and location data with potentially unknown contacts.

As a school what we are doing:

- Teaching online safety in our lessons.
- Speaking individually with students involved in concerning incidents.
- Providing additional support for any students affected by online behavior.

How You can help:

As parents/carers, you play a crucial role in your child's online safety:

- **Check your child's phone regularly** to monitor WhatsApp and other messaging apps.
- **Discuss appropriate online behavior** and the real-world impact of digital actions.
- **Set clear boundaries** regarding when and how messaging apps can be used.
- **Consider whether your child is ready** for the responsibilities of WhatsApp Facebook usage.
- **Keep devices out of bedrooms overnight** to prevent late-night messaging.
- **Reporting any concerning messages** to the school and, if appropriate, to the authorities.
